1. I,

declare this to be my last Will.
2. I declare myself to be a Muslim. I bear witness that there is nothing worthy of worship except Allāh, the One and Only true God and I bear witness that the Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, is the last Messenger and Prophet of Allāh.
3. After I die, I would like my funeral and my burial to be conducted according to my Faith.
4. I would like my estate (all my property, possessions and money) to be distributed according to my Faith.

NOTES:

1. This Will is designed to try to ensure your estate after your death is distributed according to your religion.
2. This basic Will template has been drafted for Muslims living in England and Wales. For a more detailed customised Will visit <https://FreelslamicWill.com>
3. This Will template can be used by Muslims whose estate is worth up to £325,000.
4. Choose your executor carefully, someone who is a Muslim like you, whom you trust because he will be responsible for managing your estate after your death. The Will template allows you to nominate up to 3 executors.
5. The signing procedure is very important. You and your two witnesses must sign the Will in the presence of each other at the same time.
6. Your witnesses do not need to know the contents of the Will.
7. Tell your relatives that you have written the Will. You can share the contents of the Will with them if you wish.
8. Keep your Will in a safe place. Tell your executors where you are keeping your Will.
